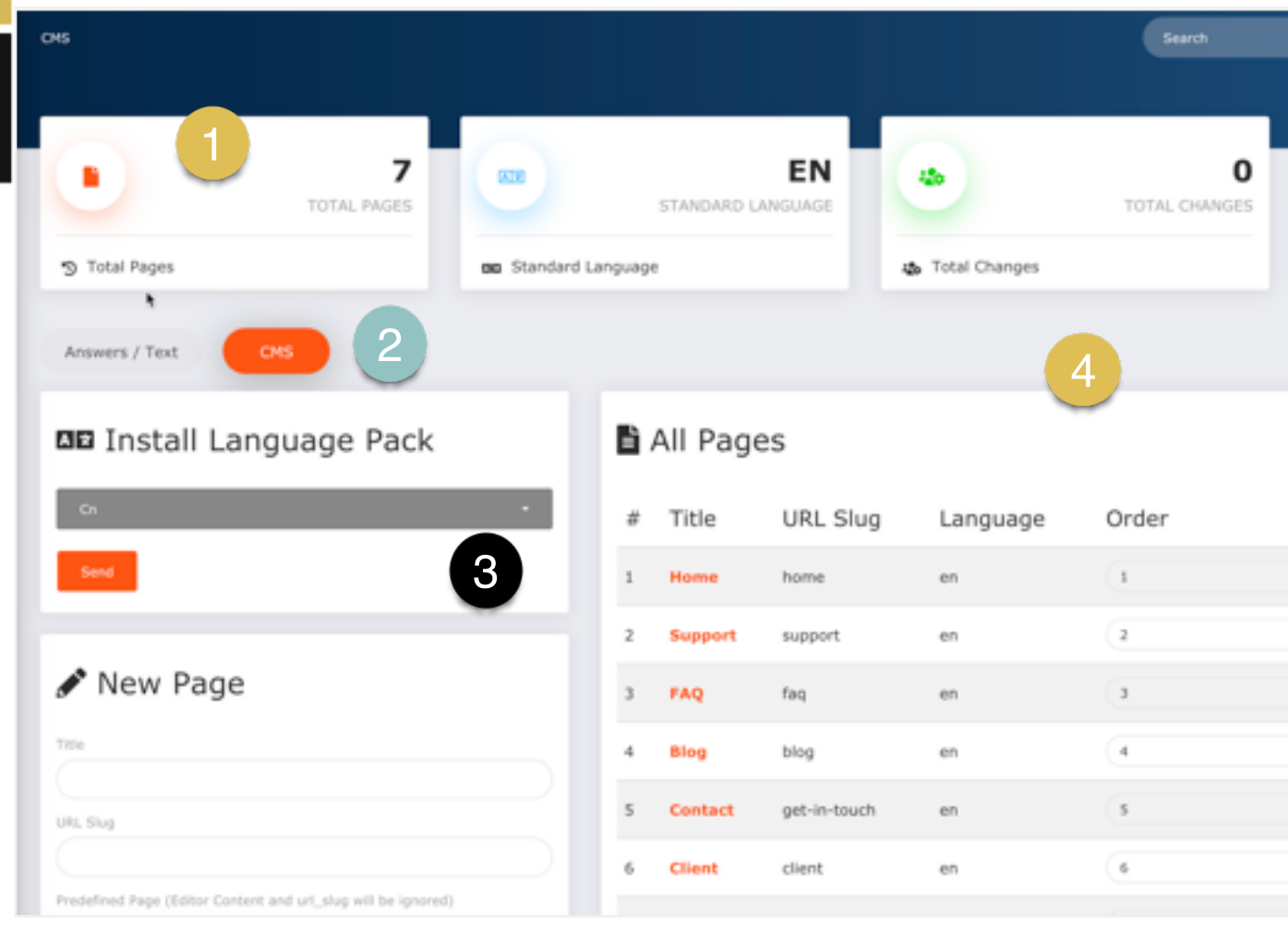


# 10. CMS

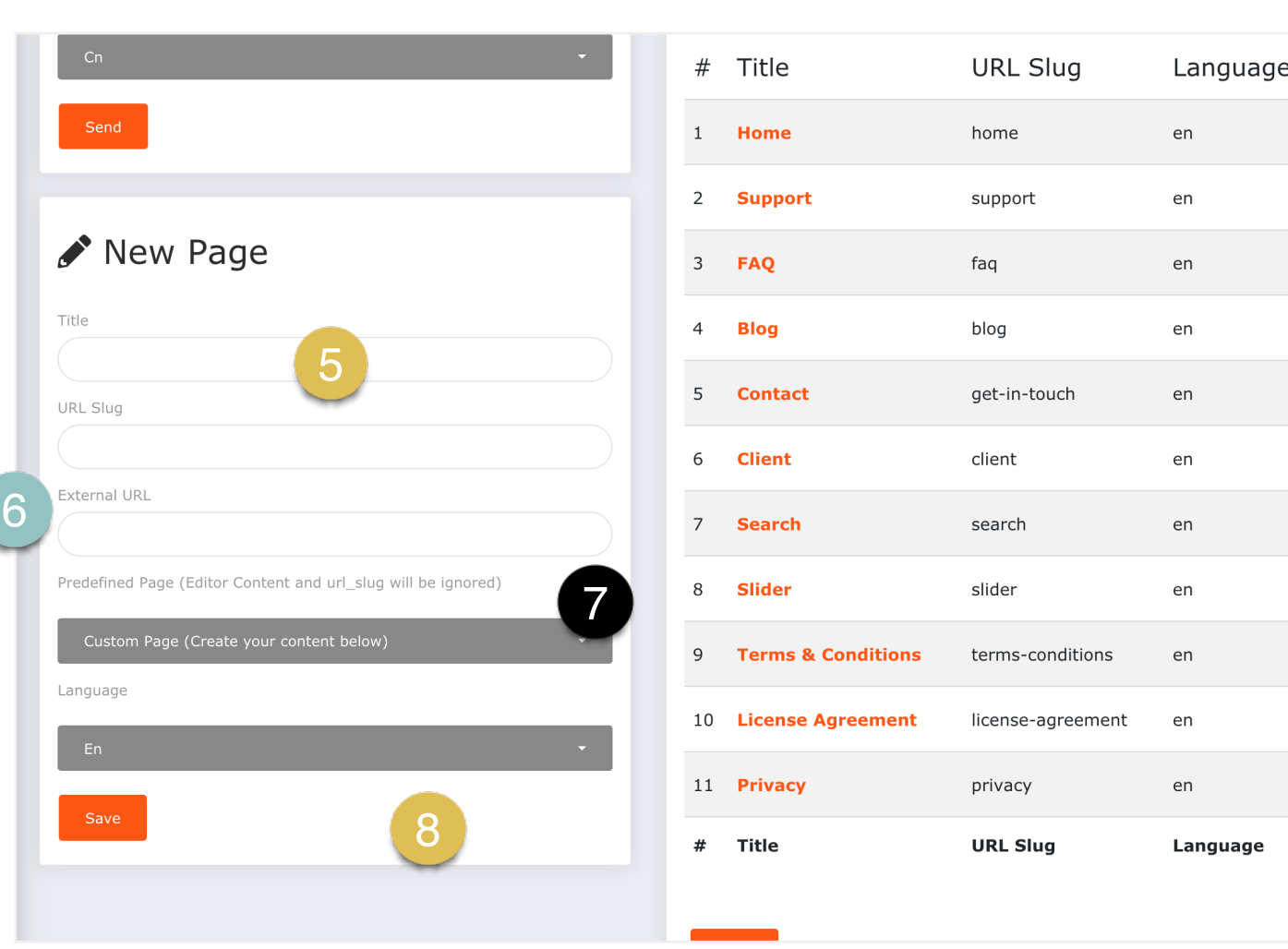


**1** Quick Statistics about the CMS Area. The CMS Area contains all the pages for the front end. Here you can create new pages and modify existing ones.

**2** Quick navigation between the Answers / Text and CMS Pages.

**3** Like to have your HelpDesk 3 multi lingual? Simply install a language pack and translate all the pages, this way nothing gets forget.

**4** In the table it shows all the available pages in all kind of languages (optional). More details see numbers 9 - 12 below.

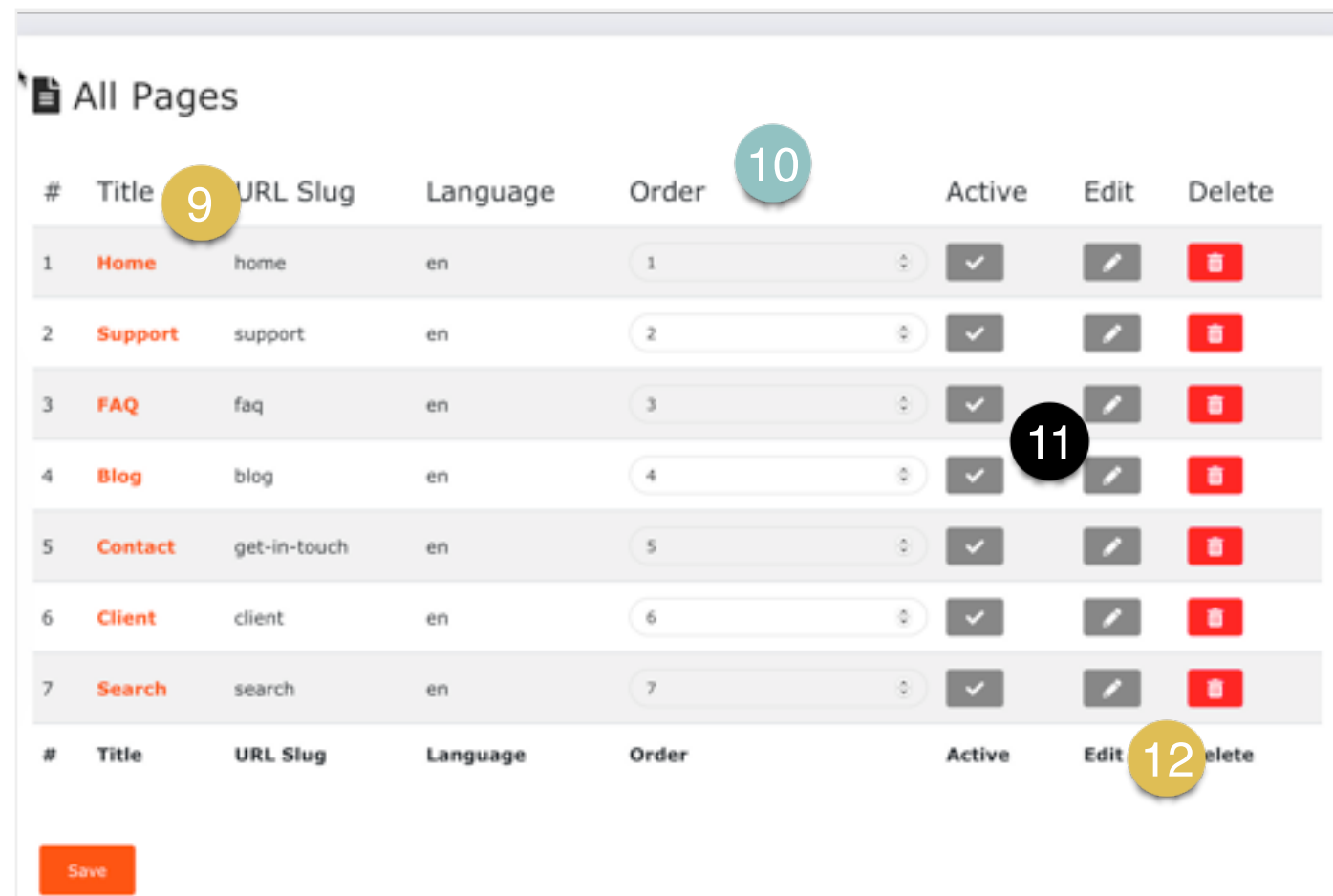


**5** Create a new page with the form provided. This form has many options and are described in the next points.

**6** When you start typing a title it suggests you an URL Slug (that will be the link to your individual page). You can also add an external link, leave it empty to ignore the URL.

**7** You can create your own custom page or select one of the 5 predefined pages. This predefined pages are necessary and can only be created once per language. If this pages are deleted the front end won't work properly. The URL Slug for this predefined pages can be changed in your include/db.php file. **8** Select your language, please note if you use one of the predefined pages only one page per language can be created.



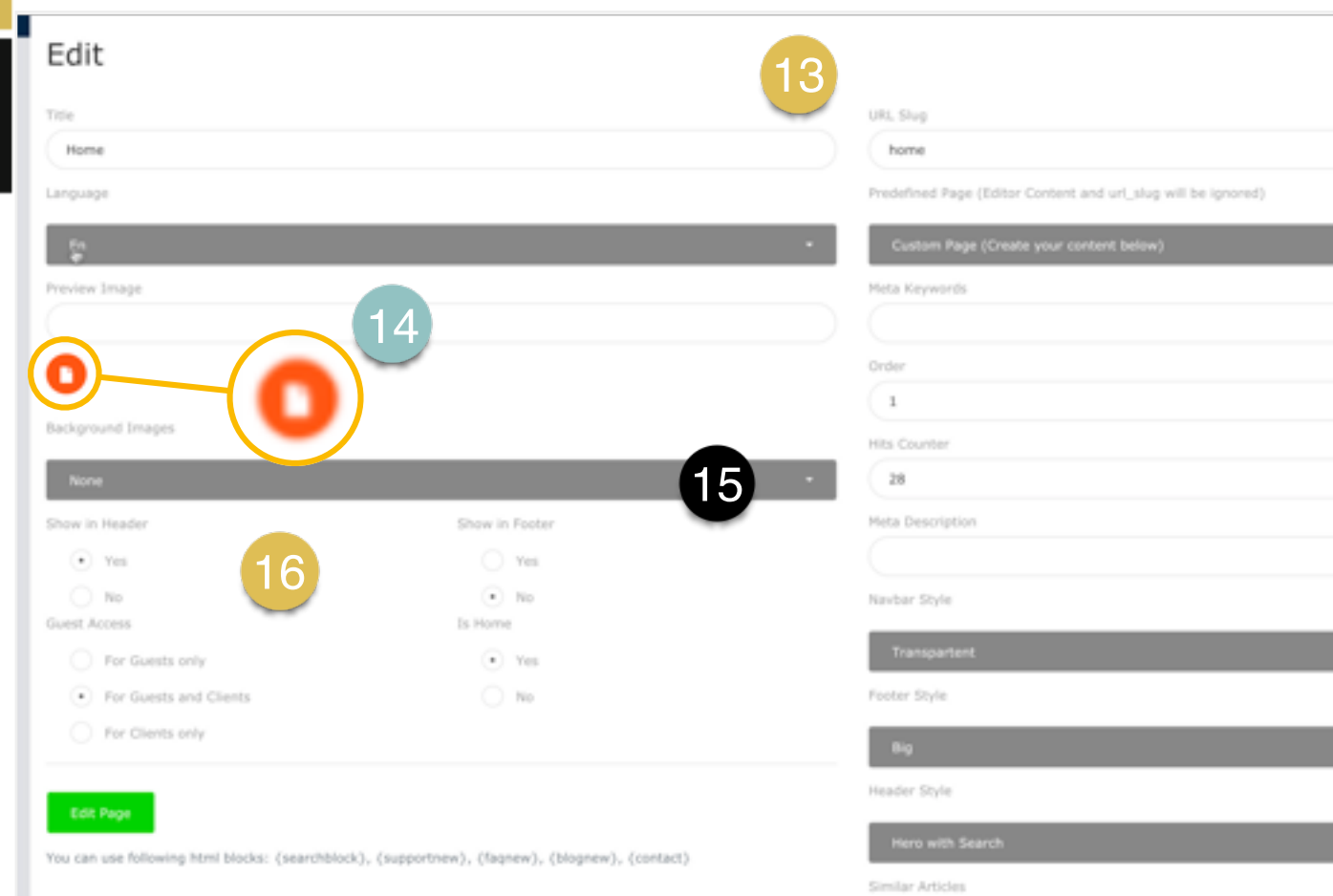
**9** The Title you have set for the page you have created. By clicking on the title you will be forwarded to the edit view.

**10** The complete table is drag and drop, so you can easily modify the order of the pages and links in the front end.

**11** You can deactivate the page when you click on the check button. If the button has a lock it is inactive, clicking on it will activated the page again.

**12** The "Edit" and "Delete" button will forward you to the edit view or remove the page. It is however the better option to deactivate the page (see number 11).

# Edit Pages

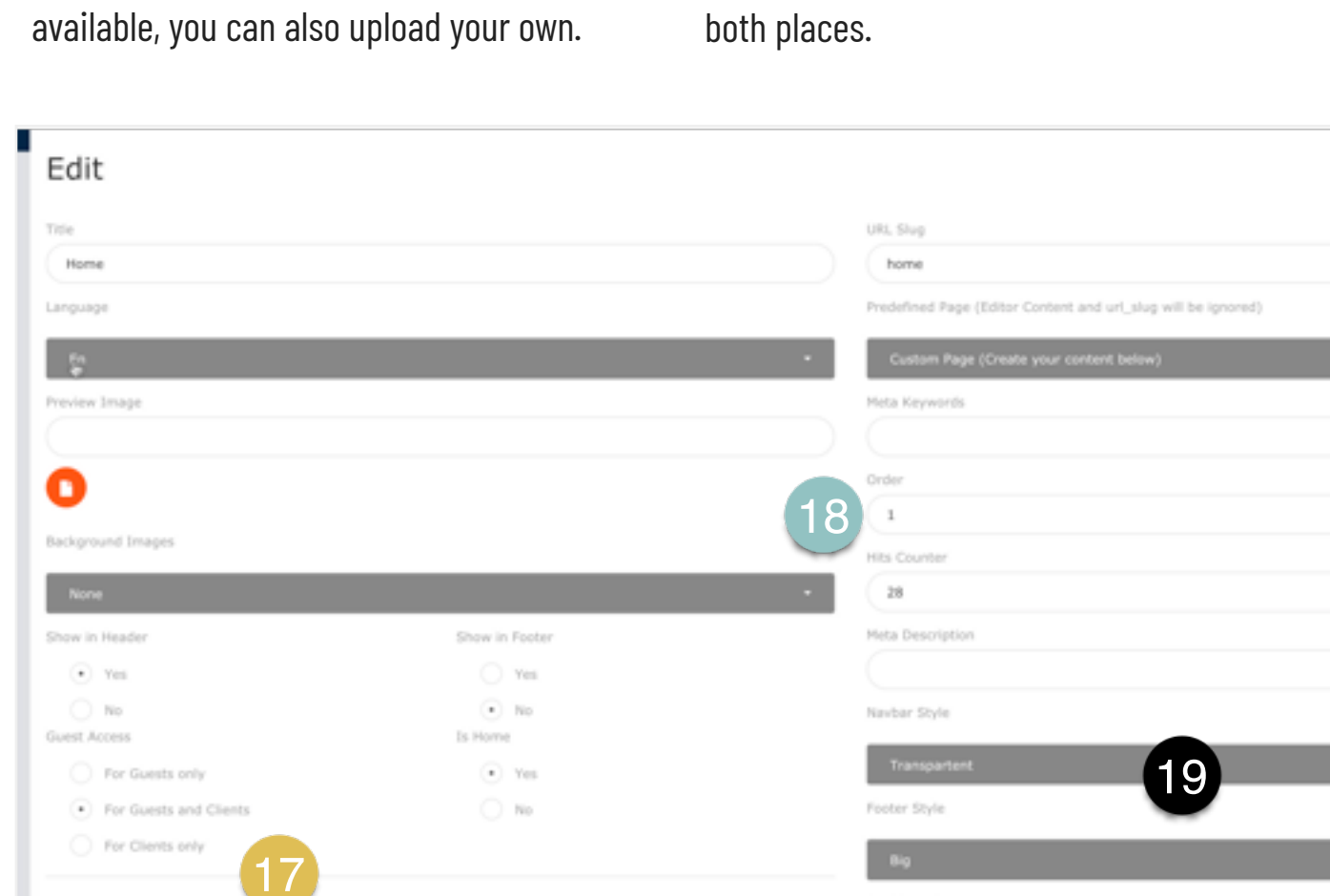


**13** In the title input field you can change the title it will also suggest you a new URL Slug. Of course you can set your own URL Slug.

**14** You can set a preview images. This images will be used when sharing the site.

**15** Set the background image with the dropdown. Many different images are available, you can also upload your own.

**16** This will show the links in the header navbar or in the footer navigation or on both places.



**17** The page you modify has three permission options: For Guests only, For Guests and Clients or only for Clients.

**18** Set Meta Keywords, Description, Order position and modify the hits counter if necessary.

**19** Different style options for the page. Each template has different options, but generally you can choose from big headers, small footers, transparent navigation bar and headers with search or without.

**20** Similar articles are only important for the Support and FAQ pages.
