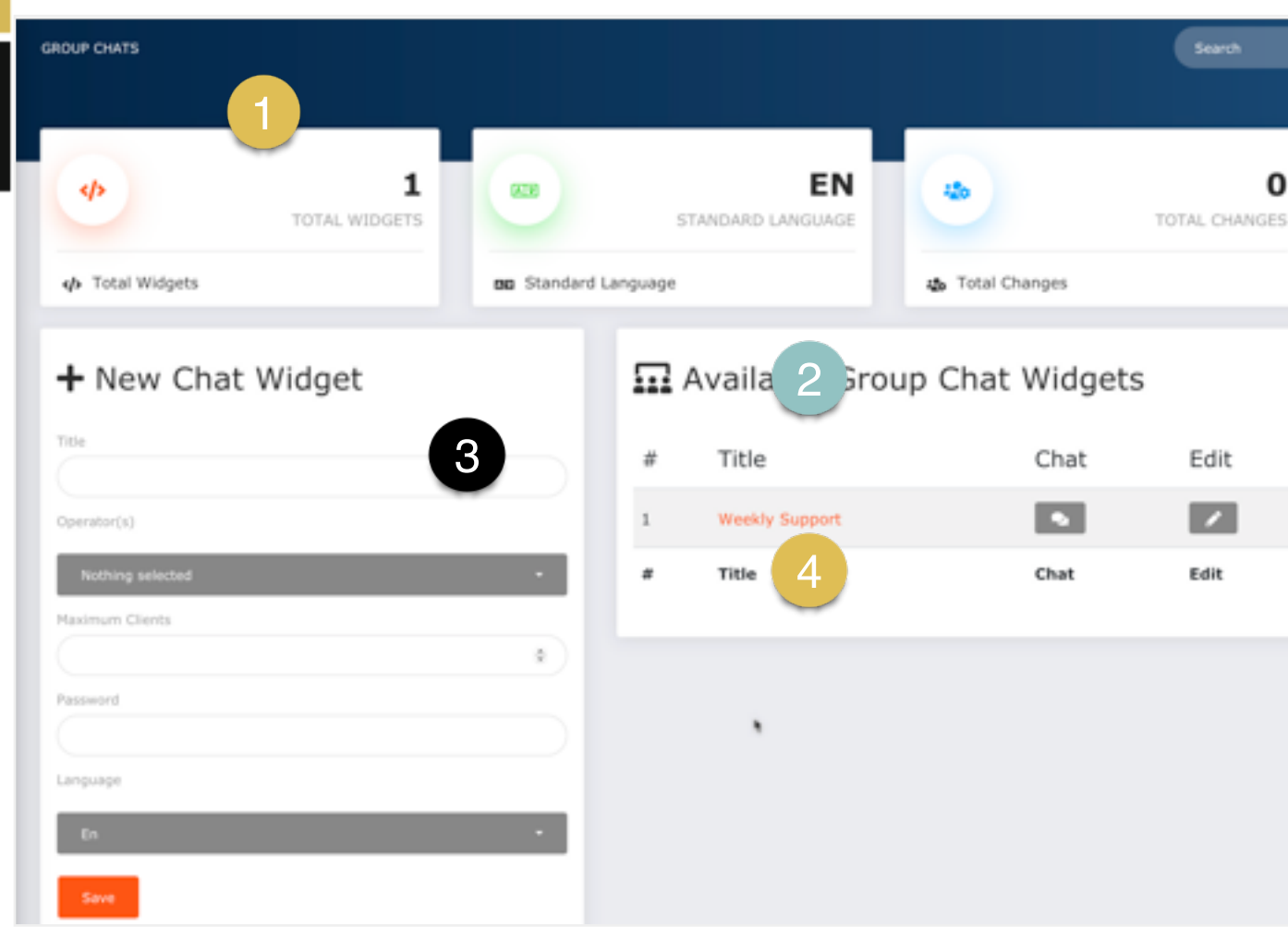


14. Group Chats

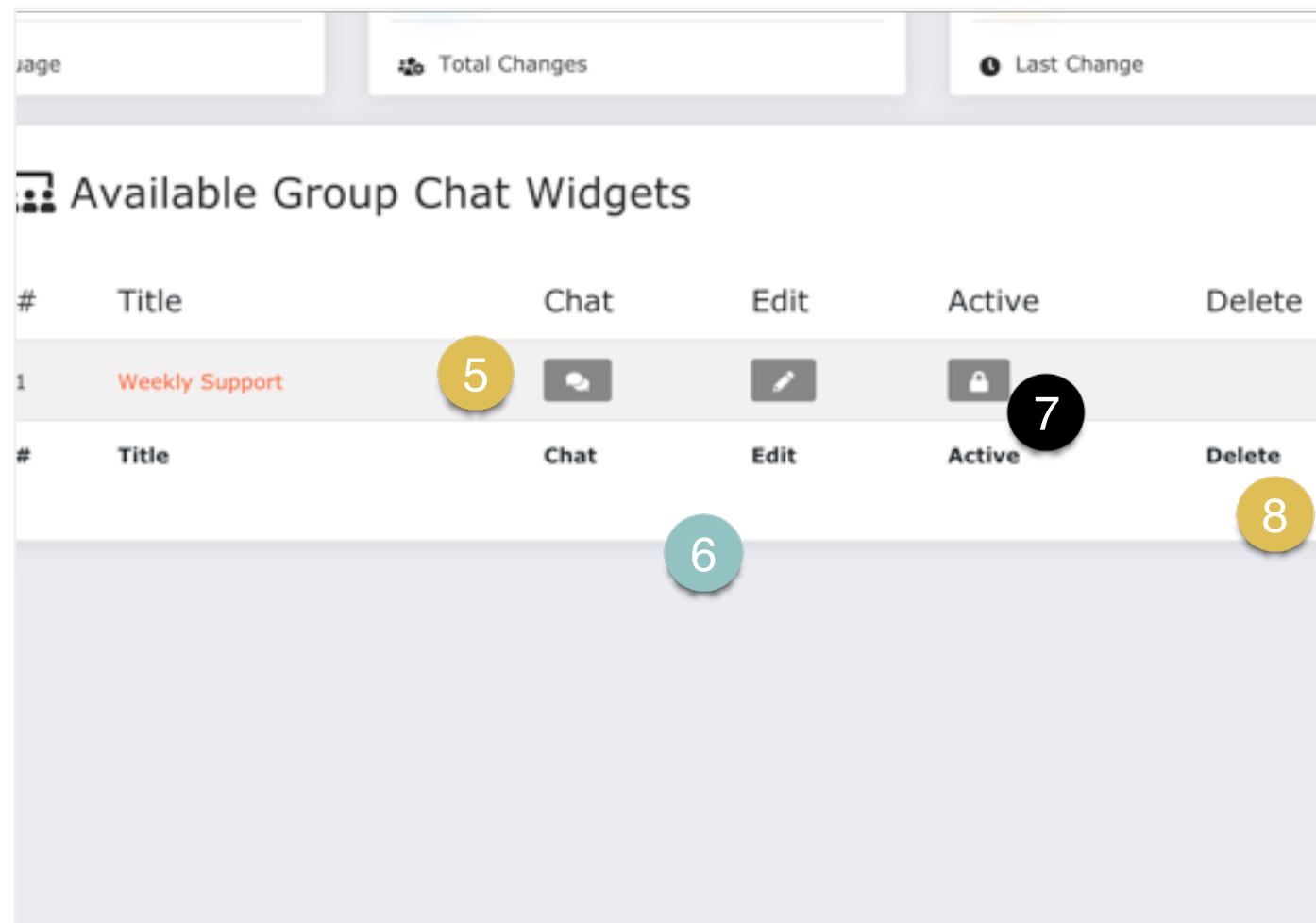


1 Quick Statistics about your Group Chats. It contains a Total, standard language in use, total and last changes.

2 The table where it shows all created Group Chats.

3 The form to create a new Group Chat Room. Edit the newly created Group Chat Room for more options.

4 The title of your created Group Chats, clicking on it will bring you to the edit view.



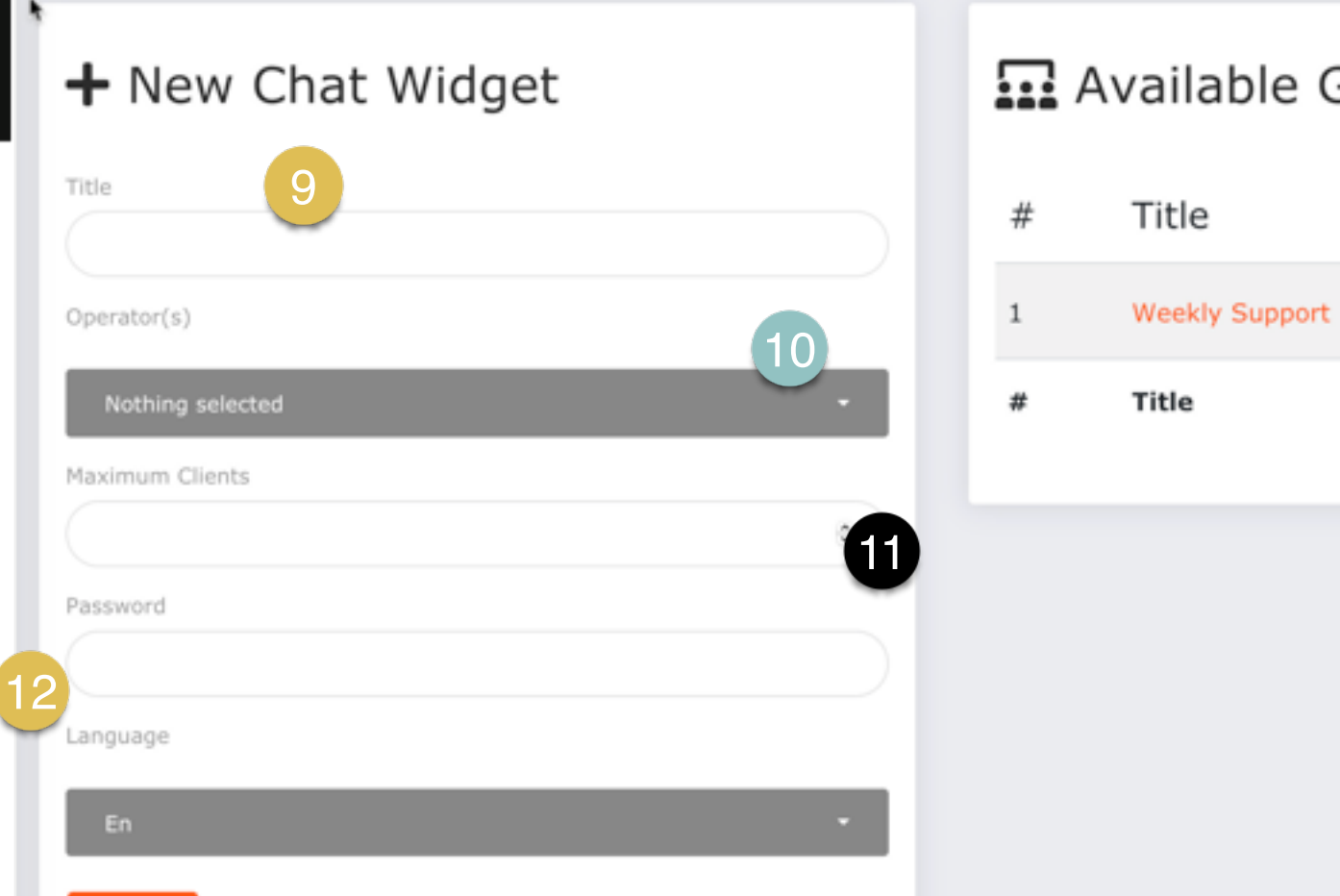
5 Join this Group Chat by clicking on the "Chat" Button. It won't work when the Group Chat is inactive (see number 7).

6 With the "Edit" Button you can modify the Group Chat and his settings (see number 13 - 20).

7 Here you can activate the Group Chat. When you have a "Check" the Group Chat is active, is there a "Lock" the chat room is inactive.

8 The first Group Chat cannot be deleted, every one created later can be removed with the "Delete" Button.

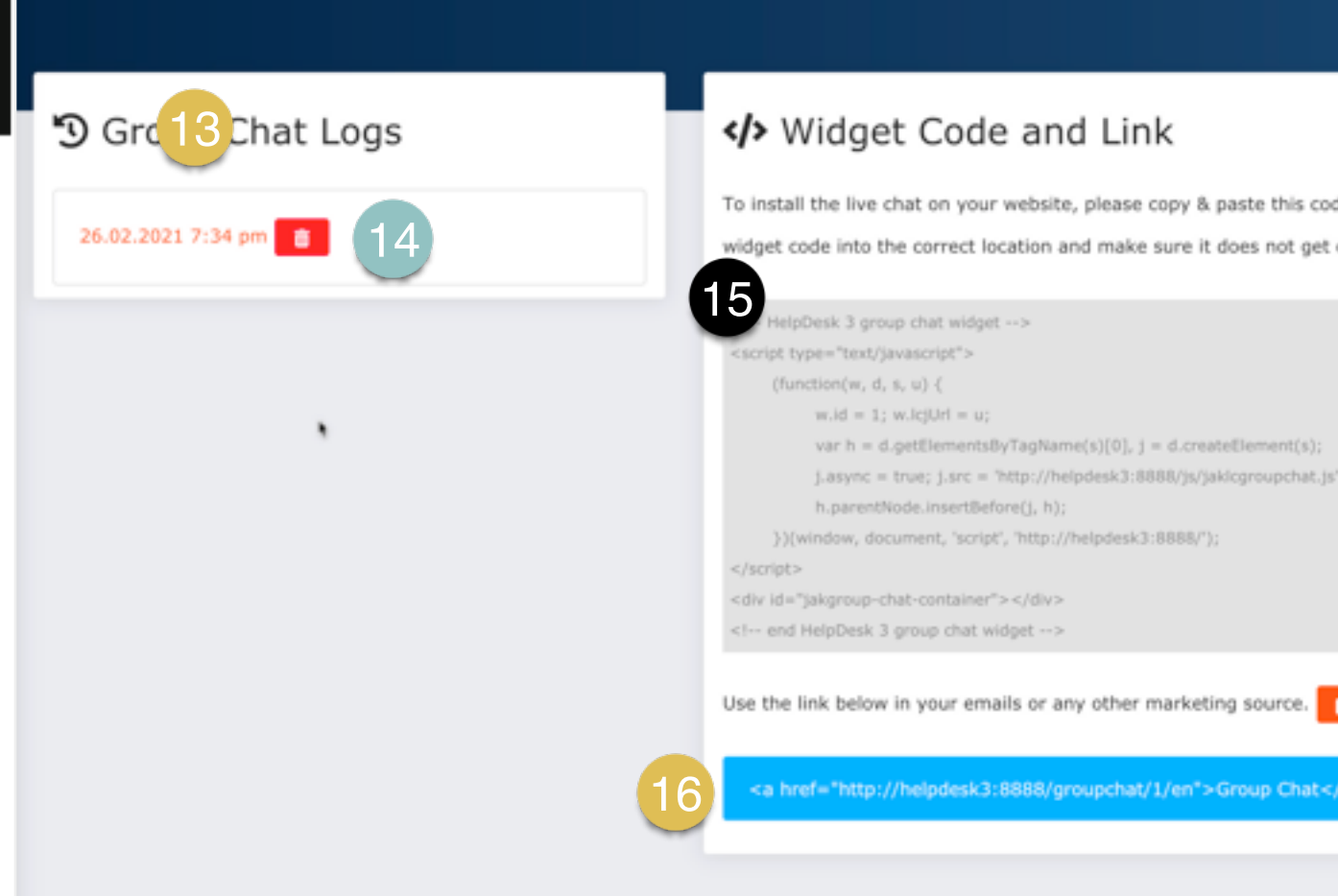
9 Select a title for your Group Chat Room.

10 Select one or multiple operators that have access to this Group Chat.

11 Set the maximum clients that connect to this Group Chat Room. It is possible from 2 to 50 clients.

12 Set a password if you want to have the Group Chat password protected. If no password is set, everyone can join.

Edit Group Chat

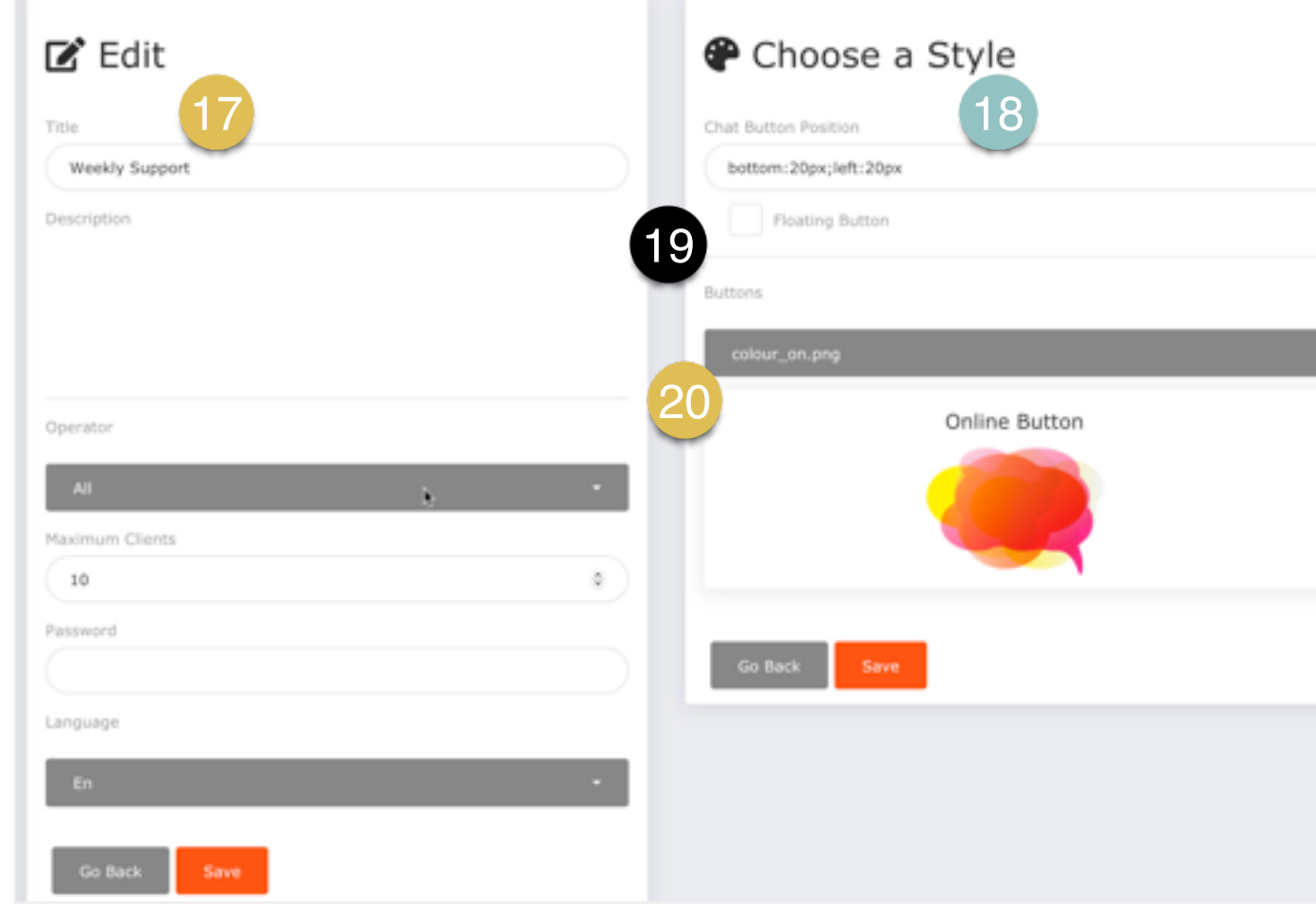


13 All Group Chat logs can be found here. Every time a certain amount of data is reached it will store the log file. It also stores the log file when you lock the group chat.

14 You can read through the log file by clicking on the the date and time or delete the log file by clicking on the "Delete" button.

15 The Group Chat Widget code can be found in the grey area. Copy the complete code and paste it somewhere on your website.

16 There is also a classical link that you can copy and paste into any website, newsletter or any other html based section.



17 Edit the Group Chat information like: Title, Description, Operators, Maximum Clients, Password and Language.

18 With this options you can set the position of the chat button on your website. CSS: Top, Right, Bottom, Left.

19 The "Float" Checkbox will need to be activated to take the position you set an input field above (see number 18).

20 Select a button you like for the Group Chat. You can upload your own buttons, for that please checkout number 30 (Chat Buttons).
